#### LINCOLN

If you are signed up to live in a residence hall on the Lincoln campus and want to move in before Aug. 20 at 8 a.m., please indicate on the online registration form if you plan to move in Aug. 18 or 19. You may not move into the residence halls earlier than Aug. 18. We will notify the housing department of your early arrival.

You must bring a check or cash to pay the front desk worker of your residence hall the day you move in. The fees charged for early move-in are as follows:

UNL Residence Hall early move-in fee (depending on your contract):  
\$19 per day for a double room  
\$38 per day for a single room
